Camp Staff & Group Leader Guidelines

As a Staff Member / Group Leader you will be asked to uphold all Staff and Group Leader Guidelines.

Staff Member and Group Leader Guidelines – A Staff member should...

- Serve the students, looking for opportunities to minister the love of Christ;
- Model to campers what they are to be doing;
- Be specifically responsible for the students who are assigned to his or her cabin;
- Be available for ministry times during and after meetings, when in the cabins, and during free time;
- Follow and enforce all rules and guidelines which are given during camp;
- Never leave the campgrounds without prior approval of the Camp Director.

Failure to uphold the following guidelines is grounds for the immediate dismissal of a Staff Member or Group Leader from camp and may open him/her to legal liability.

- Fully participate in the entire camp program - meetings, meals, activities and events;
- Never be alone with a camper in a private setting (cabin, meeting room, office, forested area, etc.);
- Never enter into any kind of romantic relationship with a camper;
- Never use or allow any kind of humiliation, hazing or physical discipline with campers;
- Ensure that all students' and Group Leader's medications (except inhalers) are kept in the First Aid Station;
- Immediately refer any information regarding campers dealing with, or having dealt with, abusive situations to the Camp Director.

These are the camp rules for all students, Group Leaders and Staff Members.

- Think Group!**
 - Remember that while at Camp, as in life, you are part of a team. If you can follow this rule you will be following all of the rest
- Be where you are supposed to be - when you're supposed to be there.**
 - All meals, meetings and activities are mandatory
 - Campers must stay in the camp boundaries at all times
 - I am committing to be present for the full camp period; from registration to dismissal on the last day
- Respect other people and their belongings.**
 - No fighting, hazing or foul language
 - No stealing or "raiding" of any kind (i.e. messing with other people, their cabin or their belongings.)
- No illegal stuff.**
 - All articles that campers were informed on the flyer NOT to bring to camp (drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, electronic equipment, etc.)
 - If discovered it must be turned in to the camp directors
- No guys in/around girls' cabins - No girls in/around guy's cabins.**
- You break it you bought it.**
 - All damages to camp property must be paid for prior to leaving camp
- The way you came is the way you leave (physical appearance.)**
 - No body piercing
 - No hair dyeing or hair cutting
- Modest and appropriate clothing.**
 - No extreme short shorts, skirts, shirts or dresses
 - No extremely tight clothing
 - No clothing imprinted with vulgar/inappropriate slogans or advertisements
