THE GROWTH TRACK IS MADE UP OF THREE STEPS:

stepONE - Know God

Find out what it means to be a follower of Jesus. In addition, explore the mission, identity, and heartbeat of Foursquare and Destiny Foursquare Church.

Step One takes place the second Sunday of every month.

"...that you may know Him better (personally)." Ephesians 1:17-18

stepTWO - Get Connected

This session is about getting connected through small groups and classes, our various communication methods (how to connect with what's happening at Destiny), and sharing Christ with others.

Step Two takes place the third Sunday of every month.

"...not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." **Hebrews 10:25**

stepTHREE - Discover Purpose

Dive into the details of your personality, discover your gifts, and see how your design reveals your purpose in life and your best fit in ministry. Connect to the opportunities available at Destiny to live out your purpose and serve others by using your God-given gifts.

Step Three takes place the fourth Sunday of every month.

Develop Your Leadership (optional)

Find out what it means to be a leader at Destiny and learn how you can strengthen your character and gifting to fulfill your leadership potential.

THE DESTINY STORY

Pastors Brent and Tani Parker, the founding pastors of Destiny, dreamed of planting a church with a simple goal—to help people connect with God so that they might reach their full potential. At the prompting of the Holy Spirit, the Parkers moved to Rapid City, SD, and 23 people in a basement committed to seeing this dream become a reality on March 3, 1998. At just three weeks in, Destiny doubled as 50 people met in a small (very small) motel meeting room. In October 1998, Destiny became a charter Foursquare church, with 48 members joining.

The life-giving message of the Gospel, the passion and joy of Sunday services, the next-level, no-holds-barred worship, and the simple style of leadership at Destiny brought immediate growth.

Today, Destiny has planted two sister churches – one in Rapid City and the other in Eagle Butte. We want everyone to see how exciting church can be when the focus is on Jesus and people are free to seek God with passion.

THE FOURSQUARE CHURCH

What Does "Foursquare" Mean?

Our name reflects the unchanging ministry of Jesus Christ and our mission to declare it worldwide. The four squares of our logo represent the four scriptural roles of Jesus as Savior, Baptizer With the Holy Spirit, Healer and Soon-Coming King.

What Makes Foursquare Different?

Being a global church that spans hundreds of cultures requires flexibility in style and approach. But every Foursquare church around the world agrees on six foundational principles: kingdom partnerships, sound doctrine, empowering leadership, family relationships, Spirit empowerment and shared mission. These are called our Global Distinctives. It's what makes us, us.

OUR MISSION / Why we exist

The purpose of our church is summarized in a single sentence based on several key scriptures.

Helping the spiritually hungry experience God and discover purpose and destiny through free and open worship, Biblical training, and release into personal ministry.

The Heading / Our ministry target

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness... **2 Timothy 3:16 NIV**

Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage--with great patience and careful instruction. 2 Timothy 4:2 NIV

For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. **Hebrews 4:12 NIV**

In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil." **Genesis 2:8-9**

STATEMENTS OF FAITH

THE HOLY SCRIPTURE

We believe the Bible is God-inspired. (2 Timothy 3:16-17)

THE ETERNAL GODHEAD

We believe God is Triune: Father Son and Holy Spirit. (2 Corinthians 13:14)

THE FALL OF MAN

We believe that man was created in the image of God, but that by voluntary disobedience he fell from perfection. (Romans 5:12)

THE PLAN OF SALVATION

We believe that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us, signing the pardon of all who believe on Him. (John 3:16; Romans 5:8)

SALVATION THROUGH GRACE

We believe that we have no righteousness and must come to God pleading the righteousness of Christ. (Ephesians 2:8)

REPENTANCE AND ACCEPTANCE

We believe that upon sincere repentance, and a whole-hearted acceptance of Christ, we are justified before God. (1 John 1:9)

THE NEW BIRTH

We believe that the change which takes place in the heart and life at conversion is a very real one. (2 Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 2:20)

DAILY CHRISTIAN LIFE

We believe that it is the will of God that we be sanctified daily, growing constantly in the faith. (Hebrews 6:1)

BAPTISM AND THE LORD'S SUPPER

We believe that baptism by immersion is an outward sign of an inward work. (Matthew 28:19) We believe in the commemoration of the Lord's Supper by the symbolic use of the bread and juice of the vine. (1 Corinthians 11:24,25)

BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

We believe that the baptism of the Holy Spirit is to endue the believer with power; and that His incoming is after the same manner as in Bible days. (Acts 1:8; 2:4)

THE SPIRIT-FILLED LIFE

We believe that it is the will of God that we walk in the Spirit daily. (Ephesians 4:30-32)

THE GIFTS AND FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

We believe that the Holy Spirit has gifts to bestow upon the Christian; and that we should show spiritual fruit as evidence of a Spirit-filled life. (1 Corinthians 12:1-11; Galatians 5:22)

MODERATION

We believe that the experience and daily walk of the believer should never lead him into extremes of fanaticisms. (1 Thessalonians 4:11-12)

DIVINE HEALING

We believe that diving healing is the power of Christ to heal the sick in answer to the prayer of faith. (James 5:14-16)

THE SECOND COMING OF CHRIST

We believe that the second coming of Christ is personal and imminent. (1 Thessalonians 4:16,17)

CHURCH RELATIONSHIP

We believe it is our sacred duty to identify ourselves with the visible church of Christ. (Acts 16:5; Hebrews 10:25)

CIVIL GOVERNMENT

We believe that rulers should be upheld at all times except in things opposed to the will of God. (Romans 13:1-5)

THE FINAL JUDGEMENT

We believe that all shall stand some day before the judgment seat of God; and there receive eternal life or death. (2 Corinthians 5:10)

HEAVEN

We believe that heaven is the glorious eternal home of born-again believers. (John 14:1-3; Revelation 7:15-17)

HELL

We believe that hell is the place of eternal torment for all who reject Christ as the Savior. (Revelation 20:10,15)

EVANGELISM

We believe that soul winning is the most important responsibility of the Church. (James 5:20)

TITHES AND OFFERINGS

We believe that the method ordained of God for the support and spread of His cause is by giving of tithes and free-will offerings. (2 Corinthians 9:7)
