"We all know how silver seams the rocks, we've seen the stuff from which gold is refined. We're aware of how iron is dug out of the ground & copper is smelted from rock. Miners penetrate the earth's darkness, searching the roots of the mountains for ore, digging away in the suffocating darkness. Far from civilization, far from traffic, they cut a shaft & are lowered into it by ropes. Earth's surface is a field for grain, but its depths are a forge firing sapphires from stones & chiseling gold from rocks. Vultures are blind to its riches. Hawks never lay eyes on it. Wild animals are oblivious to it; lions don't know it's there. Miners hammer away at the rock; they uproot the mountains. They tunnel through the rock & find all kinds of beautiful gems.
