10.5.25 | Bob Morgret LIVING LIFE AT 33 1/3—Get Your Groove On!

1.	When we are living at 33 1/3 speed if our hole is off Center, there's bound to be a bit more warble than what we would like and it is not going to sound very good. If He is not our center, if we are drilling our own hole where think the center is, what comes out of our speakers will not be a very good reproduction of what He has "recorded".

	AW Tozer: "Personally, I think we ought to think more about the blood of the Lamb than we do, and less about Calvary; more about the blood and less about the place where He died; more about the wonder of what happened there in the darkness. It's not so much the place, but rather what happened at that place. People can become enamored with the symbol of the cross and forget what really happened on the cross. It's not the cross that saves us but what Christ did while on that cross."

	• John Eldridge says it another way "The main thing that God wants out of my life is not my achievements, but rather the person I have become."
	So we are convinced that every detail of our lives is continually woven together for good, for we are his lovers who have been called to fulfill his designed purpose. 	Frederick Buechner: If God speaks to us at all, other than through such official channels as the Bible and the church, then I think that he speaks to us largely through what happens to us.
