	In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1 NASB
	The biblical story began, quite logically, with a beginning. Now it draws to an end, not quite so logically, with a beginning. The sin-ruined creation of Genesis is restored in the sacrifice-renewed creation of Revelation. The products of these beginning and ending acts of creation are the same: 'The heavens and the earth' in Genesis, and 'a new heaven and earth' in Revelation. The story that has creation for its first word, has creation for its last word. "The end is where we start from." — Eugene Peterson, "Tell It Slant"
