6. Where has your compassion grown?

PART 4: OFFERING YOUR STORY

AVAILABILITY, NOT PERFECTION (Romans 12:1)

7. Is there a part of your story you’ve been hesitant to offer to God?

8. What would it look like to trust God with that part of your story?
